When should a student stay home?

How do you know when to keep your student home?

- Fever: If your student has a fever of 100 or more, they must stay home.
- Vomit: If your student is vomiting, please keep them at home
- Strep or other contagious illnesses: If a doctor has told you to keep your student home, please do so

If you take your student to the doctor, ask them for a note stating you were seen. When you give us this documentation, their absence is coded as medical. A medical absence is different than an excused absence and is treated differently when we are running reports and requesting parent meetings about attendance.
